On 9/1/2018, Cities' Inspection Service, Inc. completed a first stage new construction inspection of the property located at XXXXXXX, XXXXXXX, Minnesota for you. ### **Conclusions and Recommendations**

- ✓ Work completed to plans and specs.
- Backfilling exterior foundation, interior of house and garage should be discussed with builder. Typically residential contractors do not compact the backfill material and soil settlement occurs. This will not disclose itself until after the builder warranty period has expired. This will have a direct impact on landscaping, hardscaping, basement and garage floor slab. Soil not compacted will settle for a period of up to 10 years.
